

Is it Too Big for God?

18.

Never minimize sin, and never magnify it, so that you think your sin is too big for God to handle! *“Surely the wrath of man shall praise Thee: the remainder of wrath shalt Thou restrain”* Psalm 76:10.

King David was the father and Absalom was his much-loved son. Tragically, **the son despised his father’s love** and incited an insurrection in his attempt to dethrone his father and **enthroned himself**. **This followed the same pattern of Satan, whose total ambition to enthrone himself** was expressed: *“I will exalt myself and I will be like the Most High [God]”* Isaiah 14:13-14. Satan incited the crowds to crucify ‘the Lord of Life’ which resulted in **the precious Blood of the Lord Jesus** being shed and ended with **Satan’s very own defeat!**

Similarly, when the heartbreaking news of Absalom’s death reached the ears of King **David**, he **sobbed**: *“Oh my son, Absalom, my son, my son Absalom! Would to God that I had died for thee!”* 2 Samuel 18:33. **Though David could not die for the sin of Absalom, the Lord Jesus did die for your sin and mine when He triumphantly cried from the Cross: “It is finished! And He bowed His head and dismissed His Spirit”** John 19:30.

Are you aware that that the Lord Jesus died for your ‘sin’? The Scriptures clearly teaches us how Jesus declared: *“I am the way, the truth, and the life; no man cometh unto the Father, but by me”* John 14:6.
